Students' Scientific Society of Poltava State Medical University would like to invite you to take part in the 7th International Medical Students Conference in Poltava (IMEDSCOP) 2026, which is due to take place on the 19th of March 2026.

The results of own observational and experimental studies, descriptions of clinical cases are accepted for participation in the conference. Submitted materials should be original, previously **UNPUBLISHED** in both printed and **e-JOURNALS NOR COVERED** in other scientific and practical conferences.

All submitted papers will be checked for plagiarism (original text must constitute at least 70% of the paper). The Organizing Committee cannot be held liable for spelling and stylistic errors. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject the materials that do not meet the requirements of the formatting, violate the principles of academic ethics and are non-informative.

Program of the conference includes the following sections:

- Clinical Medicine #1 (Internal Medicine, Endocrinology, Cardiology, Gastroenterology, Pulmonogoly, Hematology, Allergology);
- Clinical Medicine #2 (Pediatrics, Neonatology, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Infectious Diseases);
- Clinical Medicine #3 (Neurology, Neurosurgery, Psychiatry, Narcology, Medical Psychology);
- Dentistry;
- Physical therapy and rehabilitation;
- Public Health and Preventive Medicine;
- Morphology (Anatomy, Histology, Clinical Anatomy);
- Pathology (Pathological Anatomy, Forensic Medicine);
- Experimental Medicine (Pharmacology, Microbiology, Medical Genetics, Physiology, Biological Chemistry, Medical Physics, Medical Biology, Pathophysiology);
- Philology and social sciences:
 - subsection of foreign languages;
 - subsection of Latin language;
 - subsection of Ukrainian Studies;
 - subsection of philosophy.

Please note that the number and composition of sections may change in the future depending on the submitted abstracts. In such a case, participants will be notified via social media.



Forms of participation:

- Offline oral report + abstract publication 200 UAH, sent to the bank account of the organizing committee. Offline participation participation gives an opportunity to win valuable prizes.
- Online oral report + abstract publication 200 UAH or more sent to any of the large charitable funds to help the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

Languages of the conference: Offline sections - Ukrainian, English;

Online sections - English.

Rules of presentation: multimedia presentation in *.ppt / *.pptx formats; time limit for presentation - up to 7 minutes; discussion - up to 7 minutes.

The report and presentation should be submitted by ONLY one person. The expected format of the conference is hybrid, with offline and online sections. In case of changes in the format of the event due to force majeure, participants will be notified, so stay tuned.

All accepted theses will be published in the electronic abstract book of the conference and posted on the website of the repository of the Poltava State Medical University.

One abstract can include no more than **3 co-authors and 2** scientific advisors. One student is allowed to be an author or co-author of no more than 2 abstracts.

Abstract design requirements:

- file type *.doc/*.docx;
- format A4;
- font Arial, 10;
- line spacing single;
- text alignment by width, first line indentation 1 cm;
- all margins are 2 cm; indentation 1.25 cm;
- abstract size (without title and authors) 2000-3000 characters with spaces.

N.B.! While indicating the info of the scientific adviser, it is necessary to include their scientific degree (MD/PhD/D.med.sc./D.bio.sc.etc.) and academic rank (Assoc.Prof./Prof.).
